Dear Sir:

Bri-Steel Manufacturing ("Bri-Steel") is a state of the art facility that produces small and large diameter seamless steel line pipe and processing pipe in Canada. Specifically, Bri-Steel is capable of producing pipe sizes ranging from 16 through 36 inches outside diameters, and wall thicknesses up to 2.343 inches in CSA, ASTM, ASME, and API specifications.

Bri-Steel produces their pipes by a process called Thermal Pipe Expansion. This process is performed by using an engineered-size mother tube, heating it to 900 degrees Celsius by induction heating, and pushing it over a controlled inside diameter mandrel to expand the pipe to a piping size. After that, the pipe is tested and finished to the above-noted major industry specifications.

Bri-Steel supports the complaint filed by EVRAZ Inc. NA Canada and Canadian National Steel Corporation (together "Evraz"), the Complainant, regarding the dumping of certain small diameter carbon and alloy steel line pipe originating in or exported from the Republic of Korea.
